## Project EduAccess-Graduate Mentorship Programme, 2023

<u>Project EduAccess</u> is a non-profit initiative aimed at improving access to higher education institutions abroad for learners from marginalized communities in South Asia, especially Kashmiri students. We do this by providing free mentorship support to such students in India looking to study abroad.

In 2022-23 mentorship programme was a resounding success, with 137 mentees making successful applications. Between them, we recorded a total of 291 admission offers, including from universities like the University of Oxford, University of Cambridge, Harvard University, Yale University, New York University, SOAS University of London, London School of Economics and Political Science, University College London, John Hopkins University, among others. Their mentees also received 20+ scholarship offers, including the Chevening Scholarship, Commonwealth Shared Scholarship, Felix Scholarship, Inlaks Scholarship, Clarendon Scholarship, and Weidenfeld-Hoffmann Scholarship, among others.

They have now launched mentorship programme again for 2023-24! Under this programme, they offering free mentorship to Kashmiri students, planning to apply for postgraduate degrees (in all disciplines) in universities abroad (including in the US, UK, Europe, Australia and Singapore) to start in the fall of 2024.

Applications will be accepted in two cycles:

- 1st Cycle: 8 June 2023 30 June 2023
- 2nd Cycle: August 2023

- · Access to a network of expert mentors who have pursued postgraduate studies abroad;
- $\cdot$  Mentee-only workshops on all aspects of university application processes, including: identifying degrees/ universities/ funding avenues of relevance, drafting good CVs, personal statements, writing samples, and preparing for interviews;
- · Tailored support programmes for scholarships (like Rhodes, Chevening, Inlaks, etc.);
- · Capacity-building workshops on communication and leadership skills; and
- · Mental well-being and welfare support.
