




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(4) MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. All enclosures to be attached with the application form including selfattested score card.
- 2. Candidates must enter the relevant scores in the Score Card Proforma and must be supported by the documentary evidence (duly self-attested) without which no claim on account of Score will be entertained. It shall be mandatory for the candidate to mark Page No./s on all the supporting documents and refer that page no. against concerned activity/ies in the score card, wherever required.


