**Aspirants who have already cleared the UPSC Preliminary Examination in 2024, or those who qualify for the Prelims scheduled for May 2025, are eligible for direct admission. They are exempt from the entrance test but must submit the application form to secure their seat.*

Additional Information:

1. Key Facilities and Support

- Comprehensive test series with 50 mock tests for Prelims (GS & CSAT), 50 for Mains (GS and Essay), and 20 for each Optional subject.
- 24x7 mentoring support by experienced domain experts to guide students throughout their preparation journey.

2. Entrance Test Details

- The syllabus for the entrance test components is the same as UPSC CSE 2025, as available on the UPSC website.
- Three papers (GS, CSAT and Essay) will be covered in two sessions as mentioned above.
- There will be negative marking for GS and CSAT (1/3 of the weightage of each question will be deducted for each wrong answer).
- CSAT will be qualifying in nature, and the candidate must score a minimum of 33 marks out of 100.
- The top 500 students based on General Studies (GS) performance among the students who qualify CSAT will have their essays evaluated.
- The final list for interviews will be three times the number of available seats.
- The entrance will be conducted at three centres- Kashmir University, Jammu Satellite campus and Jamia Millia Islamia Delhi.
- The test will be conducted in the English language only
- Selection will be based solely on the cumulative merit achieved in the written test and interview.
- The application fee is Rs 300.
- **The Centre notification for the entrance test will be issued separately.**

3. Entrance Session Details and Marks Breakup

- Session 1: General Studies (GS): 100 MCQs (2 marks each)
- Session 2:
 - CSAT: 40 MCQs (2.5 marks each)
 - Essay: 100 marks (Essay to be written on any of the given 4 topics, with a word limit of 800-1000).
- Marks for Entrance Test: 300 (GS + Essay)
- Interview Marks: 100
- Total Marks: 400
